Part A - Inmate Grievance

I am addressing this grievance as sensitive natured because there is a clear conspiracy to have me killed which involves certain members of Doc. staff in this region. I am an innocent man, wrongly convicted, who has prior to his conviction placed a monetary charge during court proceedings on the State of Florida, which would guarantee ~~me~~ no less than millions of dollars if my conviction is overturned. At my sentencing I stated that I was in fear for my life based on the corruption exhibited with my arrest and trial court proceedings. Since then I have never made a request for "protective ^(PM) management". Since coming to prison, I have been set up with D.R.s by various officers at various camps at times strategically chosen to confine me during crucial moments of my appeals process. I have never been guilty of one single allegation made on any of my D.R.s. I have grieved some and recieved no response. On one occasion the assistant warden of A.C.I. personally returned one of my grieveds by hand with no stamp or signature on it and verbally denied my request. I've had a captain at Gulf C.I. tell me he knew I didn't do it and offer me the name of the inmate who did for reprisals and then was told by his sergeant that he was going to personally make sure I'd be back in confinement and that his pen was stronger than the truth. I went psych after that. My appeal and motion for rehearing were denied. I am currently petitioning for federal habeas corpus. 9 days before the State's appointed time to show cause expired I was stabbed in the neck from behind while watching television. After receiving stitches I was placed under investigation. Based on staff refusal to let me call my mother and her slight misinterpretation of my first letter, she made numerous phone calls requesting that I be placed on PM. I specifically stated that I was not requesting PM, but was ordered by the witnessing captain to state what I knew because it was being imposed upon me; and put that I was not requesting it in the statement. Stabbed in the neck from behind and that while in confinement I heard that the word was that someone from the government had the guy to set up the situation to get rid of me. I also stated that based on what I knew I did not want protective management. I wanted to either be released back on the compound where I am familiar with my environment or to be transferred out of the region. After making that statement I later heard that there was an officer involved. I also heard that I was supposedly bullying the guy. (The officer on site during the incident Sgt. Graham said that he witnessed my roommate Luis Ortiz stab me in the dayroom and they found him with the knife). I know the one about me bullying the guy is not true and being in confinement you hear a lot of things.

On 11/04/10 I discussed these things with Colonel Brown emphasizing that I would like to be ~~set~~ released to take care of my legal work or to be transferred out of the region where I have been threatened from camp to camp by officers and recently became the victim of an attempted murder. At the 11/18/10 meeting with the Colonel and Mr. Holland from classification, I was told that their investigation confirmed that there was a hit out for me on the compound "even though I didn't do anything." This was news to me. I never heard it in confinement. I reiterated what my concerns were. They led me to believe that they understood. Now Today 11/19/10 I review their report stating misinformation like I requested protective management. The statement appears to be presenting an attempt to protect inmate Luis Ortiz by giving my DC number rather than his (ex. Ortiz, Luis DC# 000618 the DC# is mine). Also my request to be transferred any where out of the region was deliberately ignored as they requested that I be transferred to 1 of 2 camps in the same region. These calculated decisions by DCC administration confirms my suspicion. If being stabbed in the neck from behind with information that an unprovoked contract is out on someone and officials ~~are~~ ^{are} involved is not reason enough to move someone out the region then I don't know what is. I am concerned

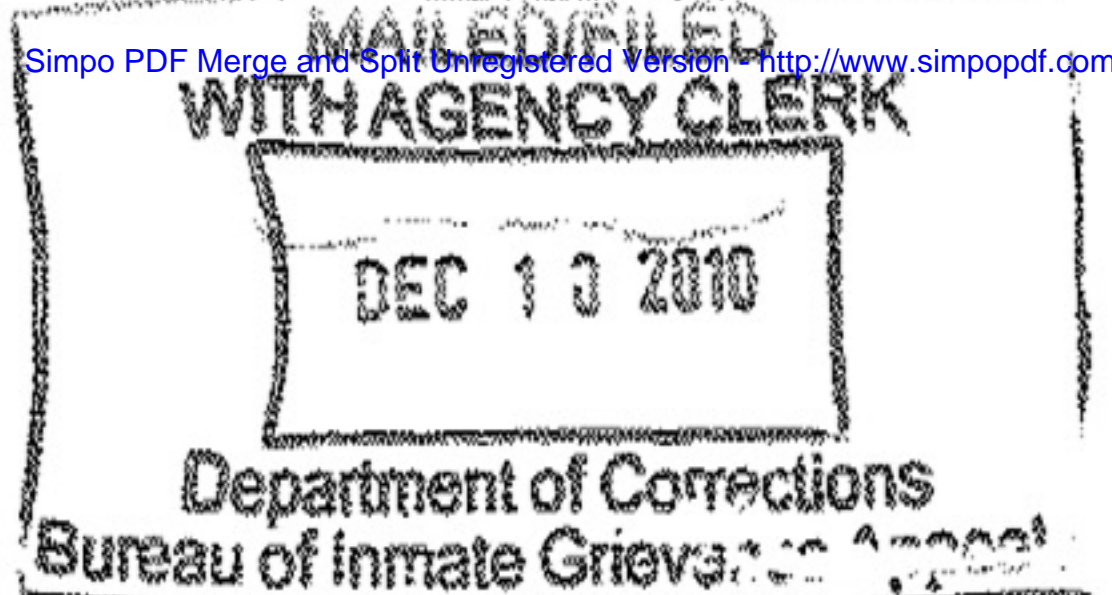

ON OCTOBER 15, 2010 AT APPROXIMATELY 6:45PM SGT GRAHAM OBSERVED INMATE ORTIZ CHASING INMATE DOBBS FROM THE BENCH AREA IN I1 DAYROOM. INMATE DOBBS PROCEEDED TO THE FRONT OF I1 SALLYPORT DOOR TRYING TO AVOID INMATE ORTIZ. SGT GRAHAM NOTICED INMATE ORTIZ HAD A WEAPON IN HIS RIGHT HAND THAT WAS APPROXIMATELY 5 INCHES LONG AND FLAT WITH A SHARP POINT. 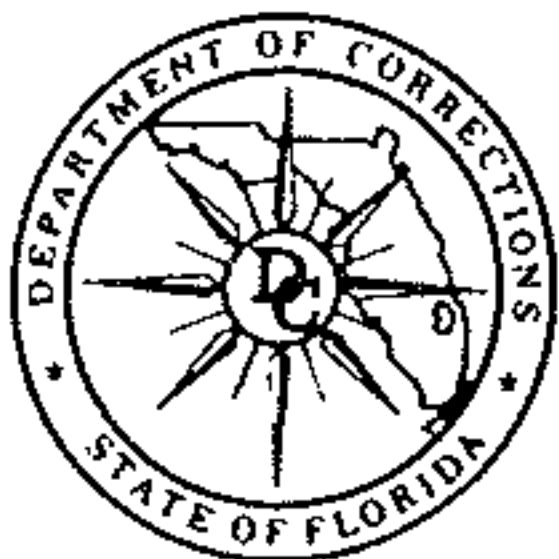

I don't trust this situation and believe it to be a move ^{to} delay and discredit me. They will probably keep extending my stay in confinement and then conclude

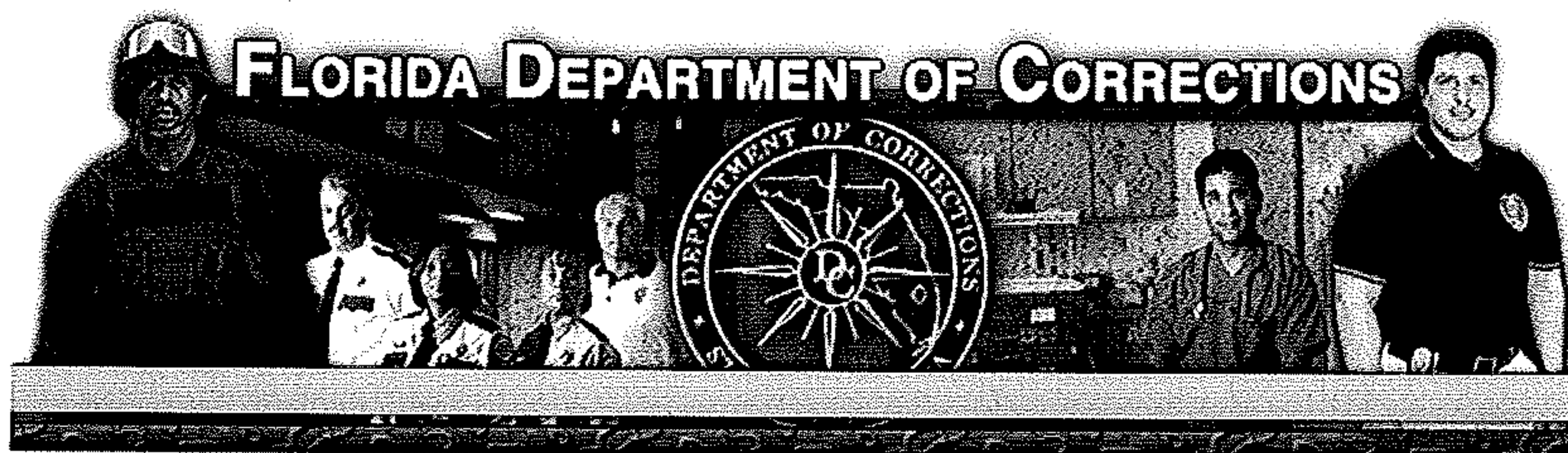

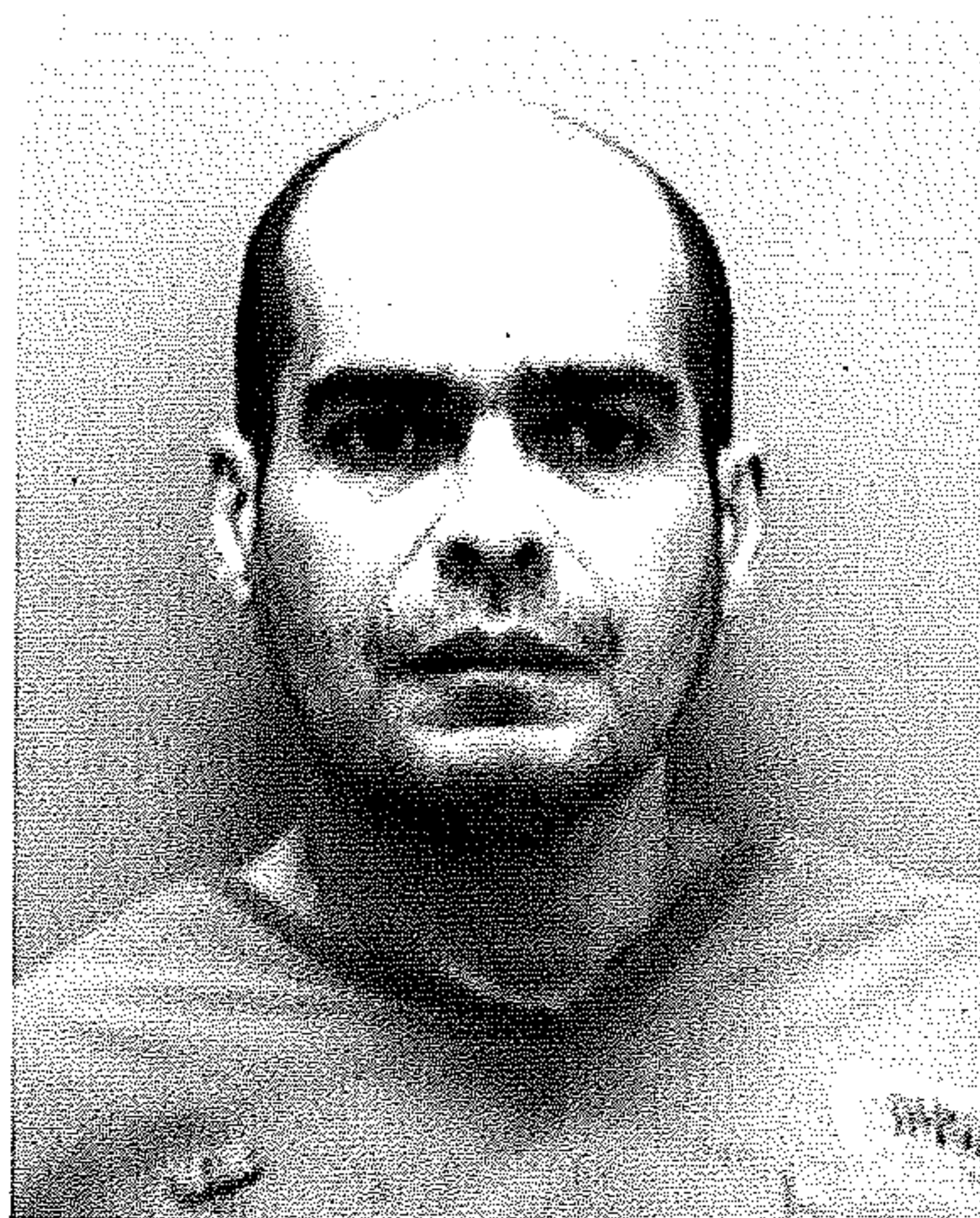

On April 28, 2011 you called me on the phone and told me that you spoke to Inspector John Ulm, (from the Field Office in Tallahassee). You told me that you will be doing the investigation. Since you

stated the investigation On April 28,2011 for the incident that occurred at Liberty Correctional Institution, on October 15, 2010, I am requesting a complaint number.

On about May 16 ,2011, I called you to get an update of the investigation, you informed me that you put John into "Administration Confinement " on April 28,2011, you also told me that he refused to be put into "Protective Management," and he would be put back with the rest of them soon (meaning back into open population). You also told me that because the incident occurred at Liberty C.I., you can not do the investigation and you told me to address my concerns to Colonel Chief of Security Perez Bellelis,

Inspector John Ulm, told me on April 28,2011 that his department (Field Office Taltallahasse) refuse to do the investigation because they have a man in Jackson C.I., that could do the investigation, and the inspector is their inspector,the investigation could be done from there, because John is in Jackson C.I.,he told me that you (Inspector Johnson) will give me a call, and you did on April 28, 2011.

My questions are ,since you knew that the incident took place at Liberty C.I., October 15,2010 why was John being investigated and put into "Administration Confinement," when he wasn't given an DR, for the incident that occurred on October 15, 2010, all you needed and had was his paper work (his written complaint) ? Wouldn't Inspector John Ulm and you have known when I spoke to the both of you on April 28, 2011 ,after I answered all of your question about that incident, that you could not do the investigation because it happen at Liberty C.i.?

Because the complaint was about personnel and not John, were they investigated as well?

Also, why was he keep in Region,when DOC procedure is that when a person in personnel is suspected of being involved in an incident like this in any form outside of DOC procedure, the inmate is transfered outside of that Region, for security purpose, also the investigation was not to investigation John Dobbs, but to investigate why Mr. Holland and/or the Colonel at Liberty C.I. cover up the identity of the inmate responsible, by given him the wrong DC no. and specify requesting that John stay in the Region with the full knowledge of the suspected cause?

Furthermore, Since you can not do the investigation because it happen at Liberty C.I.,please tell me who can do the investigation and how can I get in touch with them.

The incident that occurred on October 15, 2010 at Liberty has not been investigated after all this time. It is clearly a incident that should be investigated because it was ATTEMPTED MURDER and no one is above the law, If he remains in the Region he will be killed,

On April 15,2011,Head of Classification Supervisor Mr. David Clark at Jackson C.i. was told by the Law Department in Taltahassee to give me a copy of the "Protective Management Request Form"(1 pg.) that John was order to sign, after Mr. Clark and so many personnel at Jackson C.I. for months had told me they never hear of an "Protective Management Request Form," (1 pg.) and it was not in his file, Mr. Clark fax me the "Protective Management Request Form" on April 15,2011, it did not have an fax address on it to show were it came from and it did not have a date to show when it was fax to me as it should have according to Federal Law.

Ironically and Suspiciously , On April 15, 2011 Head of Classification Supervisor Mr. David Clark from Jackson C.I. was transfered to Liberty C.I. on the same day(April 15, 2011), Head of

Today I received a receipt for certified mail stamped May 20, 2011. I did not mail it to you and do not know who did. I don't know what it says, but be careful it smells like a set up. I am not even able to mail anything certified in my current situation, as far as I know. As you know I am still in confinement at Jackson C.I. due to this so-called investigation. The evidence is in black and white. They have the same paper work posted on the site (by the way you can post this with it as well). The investigation should be to look at the paper work and see the evidence, then they should conclude by getting me out of the region for precautionary measures. Their efforts to find reasons to keep me here heighten my suspicion about the magnitude of the conspiracy. I pray that you are not harmed or deceived by whatever they sent you.

As you know, Mr. Holland, the head of classification at Liberty C.I.; who recommended that I remain in this region and filed the report giving the guy who is reported to have stabbed me in the back of the neck at the behest of some state authority an altered DC number (which actually belonged to me, therefore concealing his identity since there are a hundred people with that same name in D.C.), has been transferred from Liberty C.I. here to Jackson following me.

Today he visited me here in confinement inquiring about the investigation, which he is no doubt a subject of. He stood in front of my cell talking to me about my case for about 20 minutes. He tried to convince me that I was delusional. He said the man who snuck up and stabbed me in the neck didn't want to kill me, because if he did then I'd be dead. I don't know who he thinks he's talking to because that man is not the first person to want

Somebody dead and failed. He didn't say anything about my statement that they made me sit in the waiting room at medical for around 2 hours with a hole in my neck before taking me to the hospital. The officers stood around me all that time looking at me like they couldn't believe I was still alive, like they were waiting for me fall over or show weakness. It was my reflexes that saved me. The blade still penetrated about a inch deep in my neck. The man knew what he was doing, but he was scared that's why he missed the artery. He knew his only chance was a sneak attack. That's why when I turned around and we were face to face he almost fell over somebody when I moved towards him. He had the knife and I had nothing but my hands and a hole in my neck. We faced off for at least 30 seconds, but when I went toward him and he backed up I knew I would have to chase him and if I knew for sure he didn't hit the artery I would have. The police watched and didn't do anything. When I saw that he was too scared I had to tell the sergeant who was just staring to open the door so I could go to medical 3 times. I could tell he didn't want to, but the dude with the knife went up stairs and I wasn't going to chase him with a hole in my neck.

Anyway, I'm sorry, back to this certified mail thing. I've been in confinement for about a month so you know it wasn't me. I wonder if they charged it to my inmate account. They still have my I.D. in property and even though I sent a request for it I haven't received it. Mr. Holland says that maybe a inmate is messing with it, but I let him know none of them have your address not unless someone gave it to them from property, and still, I don't have personal relationships with these niggas guys. I must admit I am concerned about this move they made; especially someone having your address. I'm so glad you don't live in Florida. It must have a strategic purpose, that's

Why I'm writing you immediately. I'm sorry you have to deal with this mess. They were supposed to release me from investigative confinement after 21 days, unless they asked for an extension (which I was not informed that they did). I lost about 10 pounds, I weigh about 183 now, and they might keep me back here for 6 months, just to drag me, but trust me I'm just as strong and clear minded as ever. Be careful of anything that's not clearly in my handwriting. You know I'm heavy handed with a pen. Stay beautiful and remember the best warriors fight and war with peace of mind. I believe they are getting more desperate and things may get even uglier. I love you, and thanks for looking out for my kids with the books and the clothes. Send my love.

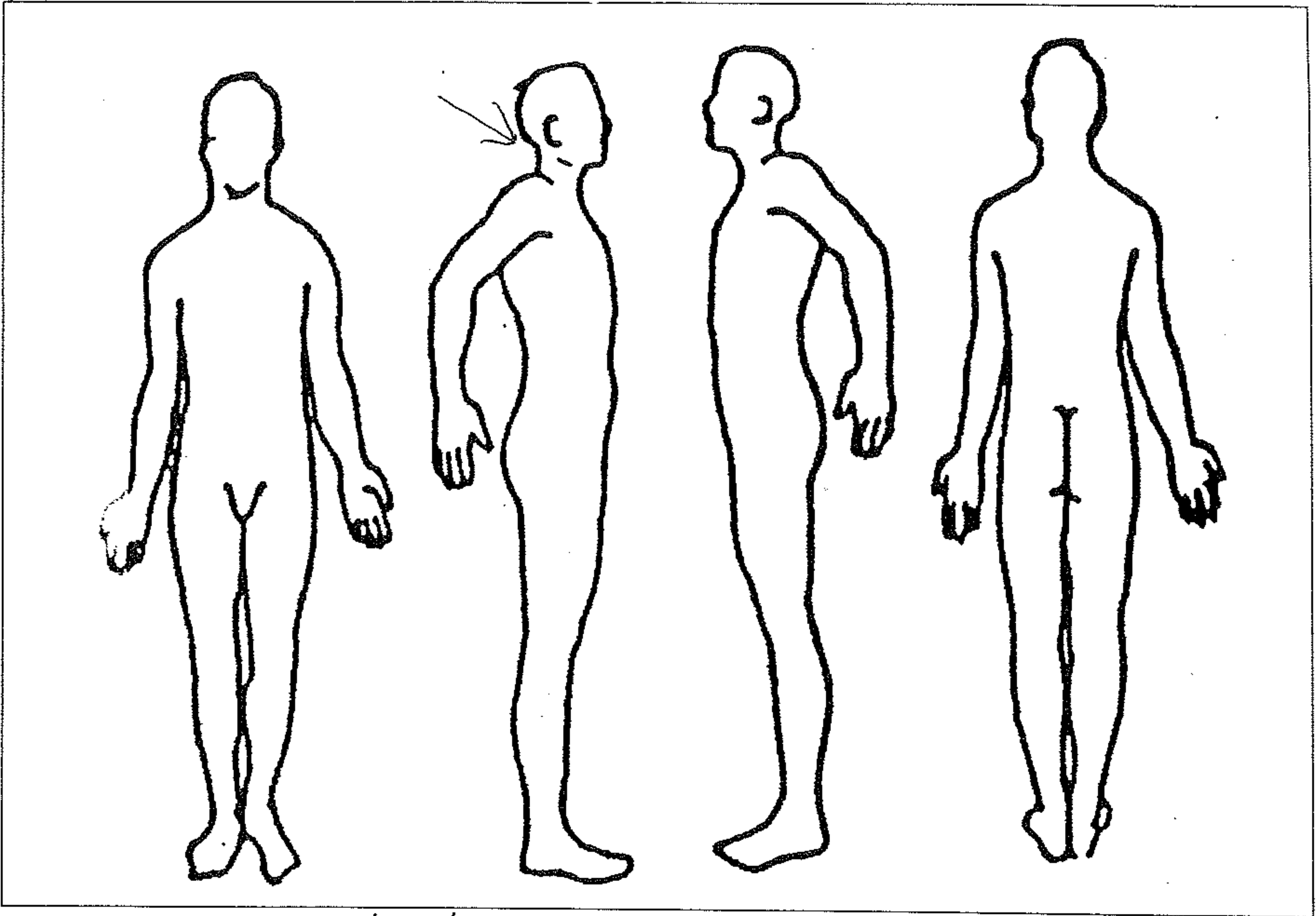
